The Body of Art, A Festival of Nude Art.
Cypress Cove Nudist Resort and Spa

1. Must I be a nudist or be nude during the art show to exhibit at the Festival of Nude Art?

No it is not necessary for you to be a nudist or to be nude during the art show. However because of the venue you should expect to see some nudity.

2. What type of nude art works will be exhibited?

We are a fairly conservative, family oriented business. We will expect art work to be art but not erotica.

3. May we use the facilities while we are there?

You are welcome to use the facilities but keep in mind a few simple rules.

- We always carry a towel to sit on.
- We always take a soap shower before entering the hot tubs or pools.
- The pool and pool deck are nude areas, not clothing optional. The lakefront is clothing optional to allow you a transition area where you may be comfortable while adjusting to being nude.
- No photography at anytime, in any area without prior approval from the front office. The front desk will be more than happy to give you a tour of the facility, explain our rules, and answer any questions you may have concerning our resort or nude recreation.

4. May I take photos of my booth?

You may take a photo or two of YOUR booth during the hours prior to the opening of the show. No cameras are allowed on this property at anytime during the show.

5. Will the show be open to the general public?

Yes, the show will be open to the general public. We want this to become an art show that offers a venue for artists to be able show and sell their nude artwork. A lot of the art shows in the Central Florida area have in years past requested that no nude art be displayed, and we would like to fill that void for the general public and artists alike.

6. What type of facilities do you have?

We are a 260 acre resort with hotel, camping and residential community. The festival will take place on a large grassy lawn overlooking the 50 acre lake, next to Lakeside Restaurant, the tennis courts, and office area. Our facilities include 2 swimming pools, hot tubs, full massage and spa services, fitness center, hair/nail salon, boutique, and pool bar and grill. In addition we have a 9 hole chip and putt golf course, petanque courts, shuffleboard, children's playground, game room, and the American Nudist Research Library.
