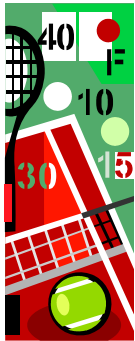


# Cypress Cove Annual Charity Tennis Tournament

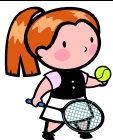
